Agenda Item: RePLAY Presentation**Request for Action:** Discussion on RePLAY**Employee/Dept.:** Jake Foster, City Administrator**Background:**

Jerry Van Dyke from Bargaen Inc., in Mountain Lake, MN will be at the March 8, 2022 City Council Work Session to provide information on RePLAY and how the City of Watertown has used it to extend the life of roadways.

RePLAY is a bio-based pavement preservation agent made by BioSpan Technologies, Inc. It is a product that Bargaen Inc. has applied for us in past years. RePLAY adds new polymers to an asphalt surface which reverses the oxidation process below the surface and helps to repair hairline cracks on the surface. It is also quick drying and takes between 15 and 30 minutes to cure depending on weather. RePLAY extends the life of paved asphalt surfaces when applied every three to five years.

After Jerry's presentation he will be available to support the discussion and answer any questions the Council may have on RePLAY, or the application process.
