**RESOLUTION APPROVING USE OF AND CLOSURE OF STREETS AND MUNICIPAL  
LOTS FOR RAILS TO TRAILS CELEBRATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Watertown (the “City”) provides for use of City streets and parking facilities for special events; and

**WHEREAS**, the City partners with the Watertown Lions in sponsoring the annual Rails to Trails community celebration; and

**WHEREAS**, the celebration events and parade is scheduled to occur primarily along Lewis Avenue, adjacent streets, and municipal parking lots on July 29<sup>th</sup> through early morning on July 31<sup>st</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, the local streets and parks to be used will be the 100 to 400 block of Lewis Avenue S, Madison St SW, White St SW, Pocket Park, Madison St Park, Rick Johnson Park, City Center Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the streets and municipal lots will be closed to traffic for festival events; and

**WHEREAS**, Lewis Avenue from Maple St NW to Angel Ave will be posted no parking on Saturday, July 21<sup>st</sup> for the Grand Parade; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Watertown, Minnesota, hereby approves the use and closure of identified streets, parks, and municipal lots for Rails to Trails events and parade.
