

COVID-19 Vaccines for Adults (Age 65+)

Protect yourself against COVID-19. Be up to date with your vaccines!

- You are up to date with your COVID-19 vaccine if you have gotten your primary series of COVID-19 shots and a bivalent booster (the updated booster).
- The COVID-19 bivalent booster protects against two different strains of COVID-19.
- Everyone age 6 months and older is encouraged to get the COVID-19 bivalent booster.
- Help restore your protection that decreased since previous vaccination, and broaden protection against newer strains of COVID-19.
- Both Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna have bivalent booster vaccines that are FDA approved.

COVID-19 Vaccines for Adults (65+) through Carver County Public Health

Vaccine	Primary Series	Bivalent Boosters
Pfizer-BioNTech	2 shots, 3 weeks apart	1 shot, at least 2 months after your last primary series shot or any other booster shots you received. Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna
Moderna	2 shots, 4 weeks apart

- The primary series of COVID-19 shots and bivalent boosters are available.
